At First United Methodist Church it is important to care for others in the name of Christ. Since we are a large church we must be intentional in creating structures that help us live out this calling. Congregational Care Callers help us offer care to our church family during times of change, transition or stress. Over the past six years, the Neighborhood Care Group ministry has served in this capacity. In an effort to be more effective, we will transition in 2012 to a Congregational Care Callers ministry.

What are Congregational Care Callers? *A team of volunteers who make phone calls to coordinate care for persons at McPherson First United Methodist Church during situations such as:*

- the birth of a baby
- hospitalization
- death in the family
- other occasions which are appropriate

How does the Congregational Care Callers ministry work? *When a need becomes known to the church, it is communicated by the church office to one of the Congregational Care Callers. This caller contacts the person or family in need of care. They find out how the church can offer support. It may be to call for a meal from a list of meal providers or to have the Prayer Ministry Team be in prayer for them.*
